2011 SOLSTICE MAGGLES

This year the Society is pleased to report that **300 Concrete Moose** will be migrating through **smaller parks** in Thunder Bay starting on **June 21, 2011**. As with previous years, Concrete Moose will appear in small **Maggles of 5-50** and each Moose will be tagged with the Code. As usual we ask that all Concrete Moose hunters read and **abide by the code**.

We are also able to confirm that another **100 Concrete Moose** will be migrating through **larger parks** in Thunder Bay **throughout the month of July**. These Maggles will be unannounced, however they will still contain tags with the Code.

2011 CALL TO ARTISTS

The Society is formally calling visual **artists from Thunder Bay** to decorate **Concrete Moose as gifts to be awarded through the City of Thunder Bay**. These, specially decorated Concrete Moose will be given to the City of Thunder Bay as a supply of "special gifts" to be presented to new residents in our City.

- **This call is open to artists from Thunder Bay- residents or former residents.**
- **Artists will be given seven (7) Concrete Moose each.**
 - Artists will decorate five (5) and deliver them to the City of Thunder Bay Tourism and Recreation department.
 - Artists will decorate two (2) and give one or both to friends. They may also choose to keep one for a year.
- The Concrete Moose provided to artists will be polished smooth on both sides.
- Artists are encouraged to **attach their business card** to the "Moose Tag".
- Artists will **not be compensated** in any way for their time, designs, materials, transportation or any other costs or fees incurred in decorating the Concrete Moose. It is a labour of love.
- This call is **open to fourteen (14) artists**, regardless of age, artistic background or ability. All we ask is that your designs are worthy of being presented to a broad audience in a "family friendly" context.
- All artists will be **showcased on the Society's website** and a link or additional contact information will be included with any photos provided.
